IU Indianapolis Graduate Student Travel Fellowship Instructions

How-to-Apply

The maximum amount a graduate student may receive is \$1000. This is a competitive process and submitting an application does not guarantee funds will be awarded.

- Step 1. Discuss with your faculty mentor the application process and determine if your school, department or mentor will provide some financial support for you to travel to the meeting.
- Step 2. Obtain written acceptance from the conference committee indicating you will be admitted to the meeting and invited to give a presentation.
- Step 3. Write a one-page synopsis of how this conference will assist you in your studies and/or career goals.
- Step 4. Calculate an estimated total travel costs (e.g. hotel, flight, rental car, per diem, etc.).
- Step 5. Complete the <u>IU Indianapolis Graduate Student Travel Fellowship Application</u> and upload the proof of presentation acceptance on the Conference Details tab. Make sure your mentor has reviewed your application and is willing to write a supportive letter.
- Step 6. Click, "Save my progress and resume later" at the bottom of the Signatures page and submit your e-mail address allowing you to link back to your electronic application and submit it after you obtain the required signatures from your school.
- Step 7. Take your proof of acceptance, estimated travel costs and the <u>Signature Page</u> to your Department / Program Chair and your School Associate Dean of Graduate Studies for approval / signatures. Your mentor will have to write a letter of support for your travel application as indicated under the instructions for mentors.
- Step 8. Scan the completed signature page.
- Step 9. Open the e-mail sent to you by MachForm <u>no-reply@indiana.edu</u> and click on the link to your application.
- Step 10. Upload the scanned copy of your synopsis to the Applicant Details page.
- Step 11. Upload the scanned copy of your signature document to the Signatures page.
- Step 12. Submit your application from the Review Your Entry page.
- Step 13. Your Faculty Mentor / Advisor will receive an e-mail indicating that your IU Indianapolis Graduate Student Travel Fellowship Application has been submitted.
- Step 14. Once your Faculty Mentor / Advisor submits the Faculty Form you will receive notification.
